

LAKESIDE PICKLEBALL CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT

As a member of the Lakeside Pickleball Club all players agree to conduct themselves in a courteous and respectful manner both on the courts and when observing others playing while waiting your turn. All members are reminded the goal is to provide an environment where all players can play the game to the best of their ability and most importantly "have fun" while doing so. This code is to apply to any LPC organized or sponsored event.

These include, but are not limited to the following guidelines of behavior:

- Always exhibit good sportsmanship at all times when playing or observing other players.
- Never use profanity or direct any form of abuse at others on, or near, the courts.
- Be respectful of opposing players and those on adjacent courts. Avoid unnecessary interruptions.
- It is unsportsmanlike to over celebrate points won or to taunt or degrade the opposition when they miss a shot or lose a point. Always apply a sense of reasonableness to this matter, keep "Fun" in the game.
- Wear safe and proper attire during games similar to that required for sports such as tennis and golf. No shirts, no service.
- Consumption of alcohol during play or near the courts is not allowed.
- Do not play when you have consumed alcohol to the degree it renders you even slightly impaired.
- Always accept decisions of the referees. In instances where there are no referees and the decision is made by the team on the receiving side, their decision is to be accepted.
- Do not take advantage of an opposing team whose skill level may be lower by running the score up. In one-sided games use such opportunities to practice different shots or even coach (in a positive, helpful manner) the other team on ways they might improve.
- Accept responsibility for guests and family members in attendance
- No violence towards other players

Failure to abide by this Code may result in disciplinary action being taken by the Board. This may be in the form of a warning or for more severe cases a suspension or expulsion.
